Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2011-2012 educational progress for the Clinton County Educational Center. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Caryn Coyle for assistance.

For 2011-2012, the Clinton County Ed Center did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) because we did not attain target achievement goals in English Language Arts on the Participation Level assessment. The good news is that we did attain or surpass target achievement goals in English Language Arts on the Supported Independence Assessment and we attained or surpassed target achievement goals on both assessments in Mathematics. Because our school has not made AYP for 2 years we are identified for School Improvement. We have taken the following steps to increase our achievement in ELA (which has shown improvement – all of our students assessed using the Supported Independence assessment attained or surpassed target achievement goals in ELA):

- Increased use of visual support for literacy activities
- Increased intensity of literacy activities
- Increased instruction using real life literacy activities
- Increased use of technology around literacy activities (e.g. Use of AbleNet with Weekly Reader; iPads with literacy applications)

State law requires that we also report additional information:

- Students are assigned to this school through the IEP (Individualized Education Program) process, which includes input from local district personnel and parents; a copy of our process document can be found on the Education Center page of the CCRESA website.
- Our School Improvement Plan needs different focus from the one that was constructed three years ago; we are in the process of pulling together different goals with emphasis on demonstrating growth of our students & school in the areas of ELA, Positive Behavior Support, and Communication with Parents.
- The Clinton County Education Center is a school that houses Special Education Classrooms (Severe and Moderate Cognitive Impairment; Early Childhood). We serve students from the age of 2.5 through 26 with an emphasis on preparing students for life in the community. Additionally, we house 2 Head Start classrooms, 1 Early Head Start classroom, and Great Parents Great Start playgroups.
- Our classrooms use a curriculum developed by the Supervisors of Low Incidence Populations (SLIP) which is based on the eGLCEs and eHSCEs and will be aligned to the Common Core's Essential Elements as well. The only deviation from the State endorsed curriculum (Common Core) is that the instructional level of the student is significantly below the instructional level of typical students their age. All goals/objectives are constructed based on the Gen Ed standards at the instructional level of the student(s) in question. Any community member wishing to review the curriculum may do so by contacting Caryn Coyle, Principal.
- Parent participation in Parent-Teacher conferences varies according to the age of the student. Parents of our younger students attend more than parents of our older students. However, our IEP participation rate is 100%. During an IEP meeting, information regarding a student's progress, challenges, and goals for the coming year are discussed with the parent as a full contributing member of the conversation and Team.

While we are disappointed that we did not achieve the State targets regarding the Participation ELA Assessment this year, we are pleased that we made progress. We will continue to work toward additional progress and seek interactive models and tools to do so. We welcome any and all questions that you may have at any time.
