

Clinton County Common Calendar Agreement

Board Approval: March 7, 2016

1. Start date for students – the school year shall not start before Labor Day. It is suggested the start date for students be the Tuesday after Labor Day.
2. The following days may be recognized and observed as holidays: Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, day after Thanksgiving and Good Friday.
3. Winter (Holiday) Break dates will be as follows:
