Board's Goal 1 Continuous Improvement

Wildly Important Goal:

Lead Measures:

Request ongoing CI updates from CCRESA Administrative Team throughout the CI cycle through June 2019.

Support implementation of CCRESA CI by attending and participating in the AdvancED External Review Exit Interview Meeting in Spring 2019.

Scoreboard:

Cadence of Accountability:

Follow-up of Board members on Superintendent's Goal regarding implementation of CCRESA CI process in the 2018 and 2019 Spring evaluation processes.

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Board's Goal 2 MTSS

Wildly Important Goal:

Provide leadership to the implementation of Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) at the CCRESA Educational Center and in the participating local districts through 2019.

Lead Measures:

Request regular updates from the Director of Instruction and Director of Special Education regarding status of implementation progress in the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years.

Board insures hiring or reassignment of staff to serve as CCRESA MTSS Coaches, including appropriate training to support the Educational Center and the participating local districts in their MTSS implementation through 2019.

Board insures CCRESA will support local districts and the CCRESA Educational Center in their efforts to integrate MTSS into school improvement plans through the work of the CCRESA Instructional Services Director and Special Education Director and their implementation teams through their Working Agreements.

Scoreboard:

Board minutes will reflect regular updates on MTSS implementation and staffing in the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years.

Board minutes will reflect Board access to MTSS Working Agreements for 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years.

Cadence of Accountability:

Follow-up on MTSS implementation at Superintendent's Evaluation in the Spring of 2018 and 2019.
