### Welding

**Course Location:** Ovid-Elsie High School

#### Prerequisites:

1) Students must have local approval based on high school graduation requirements.

#### Description:

Welding is a course designed to teach students basic gas cutting and the shielded metal arc welding (SMAW) process. Students will also learn basic fabrication skills, blueprint reading, and industry standards in related work places. Safety guidelines and regulations will be covered and observed throughout the coursework.

The course provide an opportunity for students to learn the entry-level skills needed for entering many welding industry careers. The curriculum is a student-paced curriculum, which allows students to complete projects at their own speed.

Experience is gained through real-world, hands-on activities and will include work-based learning connecting students with potential employers throughout the region.
