CCRESA Board Approved: April 6, 2020

1. Start date for students – the school year shall not start before Labor Day. Unless there is a Pre-Labor Day Waiver.
2. The following days may be recognized and observed as holidays: New Year’s Eve and New Year’s Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.
